**Dr. Yarrow Nelson** has led Dances of Universal Peace for over 25 years and currently leads dances in San Luis Obispo.

**When**

3:30pm **Saturday** Jan 17 through Noon **Monday** Jan 19 (MLK Day). Check-in between 1pm and 3pm on Saturday.

**Where**

Circle V Ranch, in Los Padres National Forest, 20 miles NW of Santa Barbara, near Cachuma Lake. This site is blessed with natural beauty and spacious surroundings.

*From Los Angeles/Ventura/SB, take 101 North:*

In Santa Barbara, exit at Hwy 154 (San Marcos Pass Rd) and continue on 154 for 17 miles. Turn left at the Circle V Ranch sign (it's just past the sign saying 3/4 mile to Cachuma Lake Recreation Area). Go 1.5 miles to the camp.

*From San Luis Obispo/San Jose/SBA, take 101 South:*

Exit at Hwy 154 (Los Olivos, San Marcos Pass Rd) and continue for 15 miles. Just after Cachuma Lake Recreation Area, turn right at the Circle V Ranch sign. Go 1.5 miles to the camp.

*By Air or Amtrak* (we will try to arrange to pick you up):  
 Santa Barbara (24 mi); Burbank/LAX (120 mi); Solvang (12 mi)

**What to Bring**

Vegetarian dinners will be provided both Saturday and Sunday evenings. Bring your own food for breakfasts and lunches (or eat our snacks/leftovers). A large kitchen is available for our use.

Bring your own bedding or sleeping bag, pillow, towel, toiletries, flashlight, and warm clothing for winter evenings at 1100 ft elevation. Bring objects for altar and decoration.

**Housing**

Housing consists of several shared, heated cabins, each with plenty of space in which to spread out.

**Cost**

Early registration is **\$99** including lodging and dinners (\$109 if postmarked after Jan 10). No reduced cost for partial attendance. Half-price for under age 21.
